Our prime aim is to prepare Sixth Form students for University, Further Education and the world of work. Industrial Consultants and University Admissions tutors work closely with staff, to give a quality guidance service and advice on course design.

The Careers and Industry Links Centre provides a drop in facility where students can access up to date careers information and advice.

All Sixth Form students have a two week work experience, this can be a local placement or in some cases in Europe.
